Southport Park is situated on the coast of Lake Michigan in the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin. Kenosha has a long industrial and commercial history dating back to early European settlement in Wisconsin. Native American culture has been recorded in southeastern Wisconsin for at least 10,000 years. Today the park delights visitors with its walking/biking paths and architectural jewel listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
